Welcome friends, old and new, to our landmark 30th pantomime! Back in 1991, no one ever thought that our inexperienced group would still be bringing regular entertainment to the community. Since then, we have branched into open air performances at the Danson Show, musical plays, murder mysteries with meals, and even a production just for our young members.

We previously performed 'Jack And The Beanstalk' in 1997 and 2009, and while a number of our members are appearing again in our third version, we continue to welcome new faces to our stage. On this occasion, Kay appears in her first pantomime, having appeared as Victor Frankenstein's fiancée in our last play, and we welcome Stephen to his first production; three members of our junior chorus appear for the first time, and we have borrowed a couple of Scouts/Guides to play 'Buttermilk' (the rear end's mother was in the junior chorus of our first few pantomimes).

In celebration of our thirty years, we have combined a selection of new features and effects with panto traditions and favourite songs from the past (including a certain S Club 7 song from 2000, that we have sung a number of times, but with a couple of new twists this time!) Once again, we thank the unsung heroes who help the production to come alive, both on the night and over the last few months, ensuring that everything looks and sounds great.

Formed in 1953, the Samaritans provide support to anyone experiencing emotional stress, those who are struggling to cope, or contemplating suicide. The modern version of JACK AND THE BEANSTALK was first published as 'The Story of Jack Spriggins and the Enchanted Bean' in 1734, but its origins have been traced back by experts more than five-thousand years, when it was known as 'The Boy Who Stole Ogre's Treasure'. Many adaptations have been created over time, including many pantomime variants. The story is perhaps best known for the Giant's line "Fee, Fi, Fo, Fum!" - this rhyme was first written centuries ago, and was adapted to "Fie foh, and fum, I smell the blood of a British man", featured in Act 3 of Shakespeare's play 'King Lear'.

Our production comprises two acts; there will be a short interval after Act 1, when refreshments will be available in the Small Hall.
